

Under Current EU Law goods vehicle operators wishing to use vehicles above 3,500kg GVW must hold a Road Haulage Operator Licence. To obtain the licence they must show that they are 'professionally Competent' or employ someone as a transport manager who meets that requirement.

In This context, only an individual person can be professionally competent and to become this the person must pass the CPC examinations set by the OCR on behalf of the DfT. The CPC examination syllabus covers both national and international road haulage operations.

CPC manuals are available for clients who wish to study at home. These may be purchased in advance and the candidate must then register for the examination when he/she feels sufficiently confident.

Red Rose Training is a registered centre and examinations may be taken here or at any approved centre. Results are published within 8 weeks of the examination and the candidate will receive individual notification of their achievements.

The Training Course

The 9-day training course is held over 3 weeks. The syllabus content is covered in week 1, followed by a home study week to absorb and practice the material. The use of past examination papers and discussions on answering technique will improve answering skills. The Examination is held on the Friday of this week.

- Ideally delegates should have knowledge of basic business practice and the road transport industry
- Pre-course reading. We aim to send syllabus notes out 2 weeks before the course start date.
- Ongoing home study will be required throughout the duration of the course
- These courses are run four times yearly based on the examination dates set by the OCR Examination Board.
